Reason for Upgrade

Release of new K-Series DVR firmware. It is now possible to enable or disable power supply in PoC models.

All analog channels can be disabled for greater IP-channel access in HUI Series DVRs.

Main Features

- In PoC models, the PoC power supply can now be enabled or disabled. It is enabled by default. A PoC camera cannot be added to this channel when PoC is disabled.
- For DS-72xxHUI-K2 Series DVRs, all analog channels can now be disabled to access more IP channels.
- A Hik-Connect unbounding hint has been added.
 - For unlinked devices, pressing the unlink button will show message that the device is disconnected.
 - Clicking the link button and entering the password in the input interface shows a message that the device will disconnect from the account.
 - When disconnecting, the following message will be shown: "Unbinding device...Please wait."
 - If disconnection is successful, the following message will be shown: "Bound success."
 - For disconnect timeouts, the following message will be shown: "Bound out time."

Modified Functions

- Delete the video and player option when performing backup.

NOTES: Please refer to FW Mapping in order to select the right FW to upgrade.

When Hik-Connect is enabled in the Web interface for the first time, the "stream encryption" option in the local GUI will be checked automatically and the stream will be encrypted. In v4.2.0, "stream encryption" will not be automatically enabled.
