# What Is Hikvision Views?

Hikvision Views is a useful tool for product selection. Cameras, recorders, and hardware can be looked up by part number or by product family.

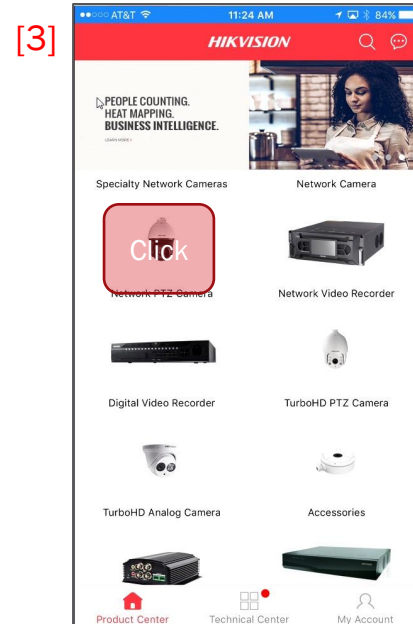
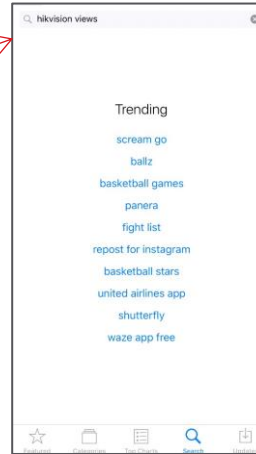
In the **Product Center**, product pictures and specifications can be viewed and compared. Contrasting features can be seen side-by-side to make selection easy.

In the **Technical Center**, articles of interest to Hikvision technicians are posted and brief questions are answered in the **FAQ**.



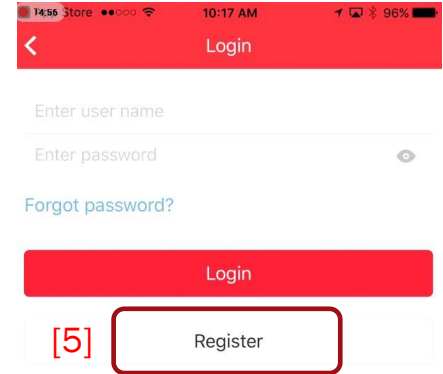
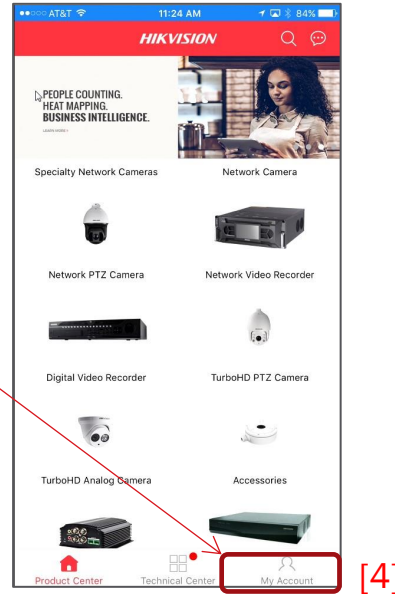
# How To Download Hikvision Views

1. Go to the Apple Store, search for the **Hikvision Views** app, and download it.
2. When the download is complete, click on **Open** to view the **Product Center** page.
3. The app opens to the **Product Center** page that displays product family icons. Click on a product type and you will be taken to a list of products in that family..



# Registering Hikvision Views

- 4. To register Hikvision Views (HV) click on the My Account icon.
- 5. At the Login screen pick Register.




## Registering Hikvision Views

6. The **Register** screen allows you to select a **Login Name** and **Password**

7. If you like, you can make the password and verification visible by clicking on the **Eye** icon.

8. Don't forget to use a strong password and store it in a safe place.

10. You will then be asked other questions that will allow Hikvision to send you a verification code and other system messages.



11. To finish your registration, you will be emailed a verification code.





13. When you click on an equipment family icon, a complete set of individual product icons are displayed.

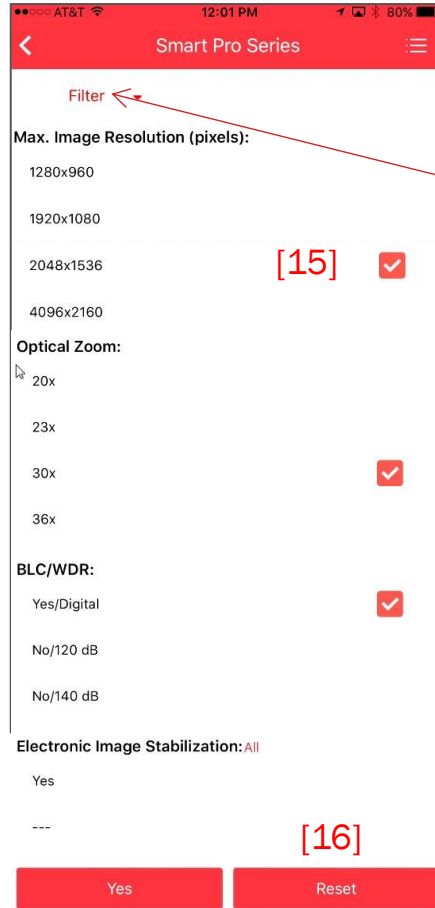

# Using Hikvision Views

- 14. When you click on **Filter** you can further refine your search based on the features listed.
- 15. Place a check mark beside the features you want and HV will search for them.
- 16. Use the **Reset** bar to reset for another search.

- 17. From the product family page you may also compare product specifications. Click on the **Product Comparison** bar to begin the process.
- 18. Place a check mark beside the devices you want to compare.
- 19. HV will display them for you when you click the **Complete** bar.
